

Access Services

Edit, update, and create linked Microsoft Access 2010 databases that can be viewed and manipulated by using an Internet browser.

Authoring Tools

Authoring tools such as SharePoint Dashboard for authoring PerformancePoint content, Report Builder for reports authoring, and SharePoint Designer 2010 which is the tool that is used to modify and customize SharePoint web pages.

Business Connectivity Services

Business Connectivity Services provides Office connectivity to external sources of data.

Business Intelligence – Ask us how it works!

The Microsoft Business Intelligence toolset includes many components such as data source integration (SQL Server Analysis Services; SAS

and SharePoint lists), Integration tools (Business Connectivity Services; BCS, and SQL Server Integration Services; SSIS), and End-Users UI tools (Excel, Visio, and Access and their associated SharePoint services).

Cross Browser Support

SharePoint Server 2010 supports several commonly used web browsers such as Internet Explorer, Safari, Firefox, and Chrome.

Digital Asset Management

New asset library specially designed for managing and sharing digital assets such as audio, video, and other rich media files.

Excel Services

Publish Excel client workbooks to SharePoint for anyone with web access to view.

Managed Metadata

Managed terms that you can define and use as attributes for items and then share across the enterprise.

Office Web Applications

Microsoft Office Web Apps allows you to edit Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and OneNote documents directly from SharePoint from your browser.

PerformancePoint Services

Provides flexible, easy-to-use tools for building dashboards, scorecards, and key performance indicators (KPIs).

PowerPivot for SharePoint

PowerPivot gives users the power to create self-service BI solutions, facilitates sharing and collaboration on user-generated BI solutions.

Records Management

Manage records in an archive or in the same document repository as active documents.

Ribbon User Interface

The Ribbon interface is a toolbar that appears across the top of each page and displays many of the most commonly used tools, controls, and commands.

Social Computing

Social networking tools include improved My Site web sites, blogs, wikis, and really simple syndication (RSS).

Visio Services for SharePoint

Visio Graphics Service enables users to share and view Visio diagrams and enable diagrams to be refreshed and updated from a variety of data sources.
